(Honorary) (Knight of the Most Distinguished Order Of The Crown) by His Majesty The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Malaysia XIV, Almu'tasimu Billahi Muhibbuddin Tuanku Alhaj Abdul Halim Mu'adzam Shah ibni Almarhum Sultan Badlishah, on the occasion of the Official Birthday Celebration of His Majesty.

The award ceremony took place on 2 June 2012 at the Istana Negara, Kuala Lumpur. The PANGLIMA SETIA MAHKOTA (P.S.M.) award, which carries the title "Tan Sri", is a Federal award conferred on citizens and foreign nationals who have made outstanding and meritorious contributions.
