## Higher pay for fresh graduates joining the Civil Service

Fresh graduates joining the Civil Service from 1 June 2007 will be paid more.

Those with good honours who join the Management Executive Scheme, a scheme for graduates employed across many ministries, can be paid up to \$2,800, up from \$2,410. Other graduate schemes will see increases between \$230 and \$620.

The starting salary of accountants in the Civil Service has already been increased on 1 May 2007.

Starting salaries were last adjusted in June 2006.

The details of the starting salaries are below:

The actual salary offered to recruits will take into consideration their work experience, educational qualifications, National Service and relevant skills.

Appropriate adjustments will also be made to the salaries of officers recruited in recent years before 1 June 2007.

These adjustments are part of the annual salary review to make sure that salaries keep pace with the market. The Singapore economy has performed well over the past year, with increased hiring and salaries in many sectors.

Applicants interested in a career in the Civil Service can submit their applications at the Civil Service job portal <a href="www.vog.gov.sg">www.vog.gov.sg</a>. From March to April 2007, applications received via the job portal increased by about 7%, from 1,440 applicants to 1,540 applicants.
