## CHANGES IN PERMANENT SECRETARY APPOINTMENTS

# Ms Yong Ying-I

Ms Yong Ying-I, 48, joined the Administrative Service in 1985 after graduating with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) degree in Economics from Cambridge University on an Overseas Merit Scholarship. She also has a Masters of Business Administration from Harvard University.

Ms Yong served in the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Trade and Industry and Ministry of Home Affairs before her appointment as Principal Private Secretary to the then Deputy Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong in 1997. She also served in the former Ministry of Communications and Information Technology and the Infocomm Development Authority of Singapore. She was appointed Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Manpower in 2002 and became Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Health in 2005. She has been concurrently Permanent Secretary (National Research and Development) since 2011.

#### **Ms Lim Soo Hoon**

Ms Lim Soo Hoon, 53, joined the Administrative Service in 1981 after graduating with a Bachelor of Economics (Honours) degree from the University of Adelaide on a Colombo Plan Scholarship. She also has a Masters of Public Administration from Harvard University.

Ms Lim has served in various portfolios in the Ministry of Trade and Industry, the former Ministry of Communications and Information, the former Ministry of Labour and the Registry of Vehicles. She was appointed Permanent Secretary, Ministry of
